Instructions for Sandwich Donations

I recommend involving your kids in the shopping/gathering supplies part of the project if you can. Shopping for those in need helps us realize how blessed we really are (and how much stuff really costs).



Shopping:

Ziplock sandwich bags. These commonly come in a 40 or 150-count box. No fold-over bags.
Bread. Buy 4 loaves. Make sure that each loaf has 20-24 slices.
Sandwich meat. Please choose meat that is thickly sliced for sandwiches. Ham, turkey, roast beef, or bologna
works fine. This typically comes in 8 or 12 packs. You can put one or two slices of meat on each sandwich.
More is better, but either is fine.
Double check your meat math before you leave the store. 😉
Sliced cheese. American slices frequently come in 72 or 48 packs.
No Condiments (butter, mayo, mustard, etc.) please.
Grab some plastic gloves to help keep things sanitary too.

Prep the area:

Ш	wasn your nands.
	Clear off a nice large table.

- ☐ **Spray and wipe** down the table with disinfectant.
- ☐ Let the table dry.
- Organize all the supplies on the table so you can reach them easily, and you don't have to leave the table while you are working.

Make the sandwiches:

- ✓ Wearing plastic gloves and a protective face mask,
- ✓ Assemble the sandwiches, and
- ✓ Place them in Ziploc bags, and then
- ✓ Place completed sandwiches back in the bread loaf bag (each loaf bag should hold 10 sandwiches). See the picture on the right.



Pray over the sandwiches:

Lord, we are so thankful to know that you are a God of love. You died so that everyone would have free salvation as a gift from you. God, not everyone knows the truth of your grace. Please let the simple gift of a sandwich remind people that you care about them. May we always remember that every good and perfect gift comes from above. Amen.

Store the sandwiches:

- ✓ Please place the completed bagged sandwiches back in the bread bags!
- ✓ Mark the date the sandwiches were made on each loaf bag (with a black permanent marker or a sticker).
- ✓ Refrigerate or freeze your sandwiches at all times. Keep them at 41°F or below.

Drop off on Sunday, Nov 22:

- ✓ Bring your sandwiches to either church location during the worship services on Sunday morning.
- ✓ Or you can drop them off anytime between 8:00 AM and 6:30 PM on Sunday November 22nd at Living Hope.
